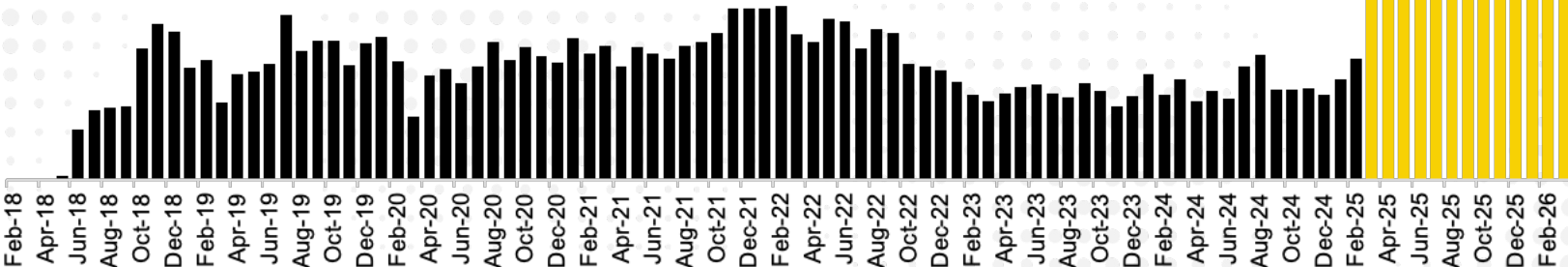


TARIFF REPORT CONNECTICUT
