


FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS DON'T PAY THE TARIFFS...

Presidential Tariffs Paid by Rhode Island Companies
March 2018 – November 2025

2018/2019 tariffs seemed huge after decades of few presidentially imposed tariffs ...

...but pale in comparison to the **\$935 million** paid by Rhode Island importers from March to November alone!



\$1.3B

of Rhode Island's tariffs paid since 2018 solely at the discretion of the President but never approved by Congress.

\$82M

of the \$92M paid on imports into Rhode Island in November 2025 -- or 89% -- were due presidential actions (Section 232, IEEPA, etc.)
