


FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS DON'T PAY THE TARIFFS...

Presidential Tariffs Paid by Connecticut Companies
March 2018 – November 2025

2018/2019 tariffs seemed huge after decades of few presidentially imposed tariffs ...

...but pale in comparison to the **\$985 million** paid by Connecticut importers from March to November alone!

of Connecticut's tariffs paid since 2018 solely at the discretion of the President but never approved by Congress.

\$119M

of the \$132M paid on imports into Connecticut in November 2025 -- or 90% -- were due presidential actions (Section 232, IEEPA, etc.)
